

Part Time Mental Health Therapist

Hours: 24-40 hours a week

Qualifications:

- Licensed Independent Clinical Social Worker (LICSW)
- Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT)
- Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC)
- Licensed Psychologist (LP)

Therapist license must be in good standing in Minnesota. If unlicensed, therapist must have completed a master's or doctorate educational program in behavioral health, as well as have a minimum of 10 months of clinical work experience and are in the process of pursuing LPCC, LMFT, LICSW or LP licensure in Minnesota.

Responsibilities:

The Mental Health Therapist maintains an outpatient therapy case load, provides diagnostic assessment, treatment planning and implementation of interventions. Develops treatment plans and implements treatment interventions specific to patient needs. Continually assess patient's progress and revises diagnosis(es), treatment plans, and interventions accordingly. Provides individual, family, and couples counseling. Collaborates with outside agencies as appropriate and applicable. May educate patient support members about patient issues and interventions. Refers patient for additional clinical services or specialists as needed.

Therapist will be working in an outpatient setting that serves, children, adolescents, and adults. There is opportunity to work with wide variety of patient populations and presenting issues. Therapy sessions take place face to face in outpatient clinic and are designed to improve patients' emotional, mental, and behavioral health.
